

Devrai

Devrai, meaning sacred grove in Indian tradition, is a 1-acre haven designed with precision. It is made up of a grid of 400 squares, each 10x10 feet, and is centered around a bamboo hut and a 20x20 farm pond. It houses 119 native species that are strategically planted in four-square groups for mutual support. With 515 saplings benefiting from drip irrigation, watered 2-3 times weekly, andsafeguarded by a protective

compound, this Devrai embodies ecological self-sustainability, mirroring the sacred groves preserved by native Indians for generations. Such Devrai maintains local ecological balance, conserves watersheds for birds and animals, preserves bioresources, promotes sustainable resource use, and provides habitat for rare species of animals, birds, and vegetation.
