



Devrai

Devrai, meaning sacred grove in Indian tradition, is a 1-acre haven designed with precision. It is made up of a grid of 400 squares, each 10x10 feet, and is centered around a bamboo hut and a 20x20 farm pond. It houses 119 native species that are strategically planted in four-square groups for mutual support. With 515 saplings benefiting from drip irrigation, watered 2-3 times weekly, and safeguarded by a protective

compound, this Devrai embodies ecological self-sustainability, mirroring the sacred groves preserved by native Indians for generations. Such Devrai maintains local ecological balance, conserves watersheds for birds and animals, preserves bio-resources, promotes sustainable resource use, and provides habitat for rare species of animals, birds, and vegetation.
