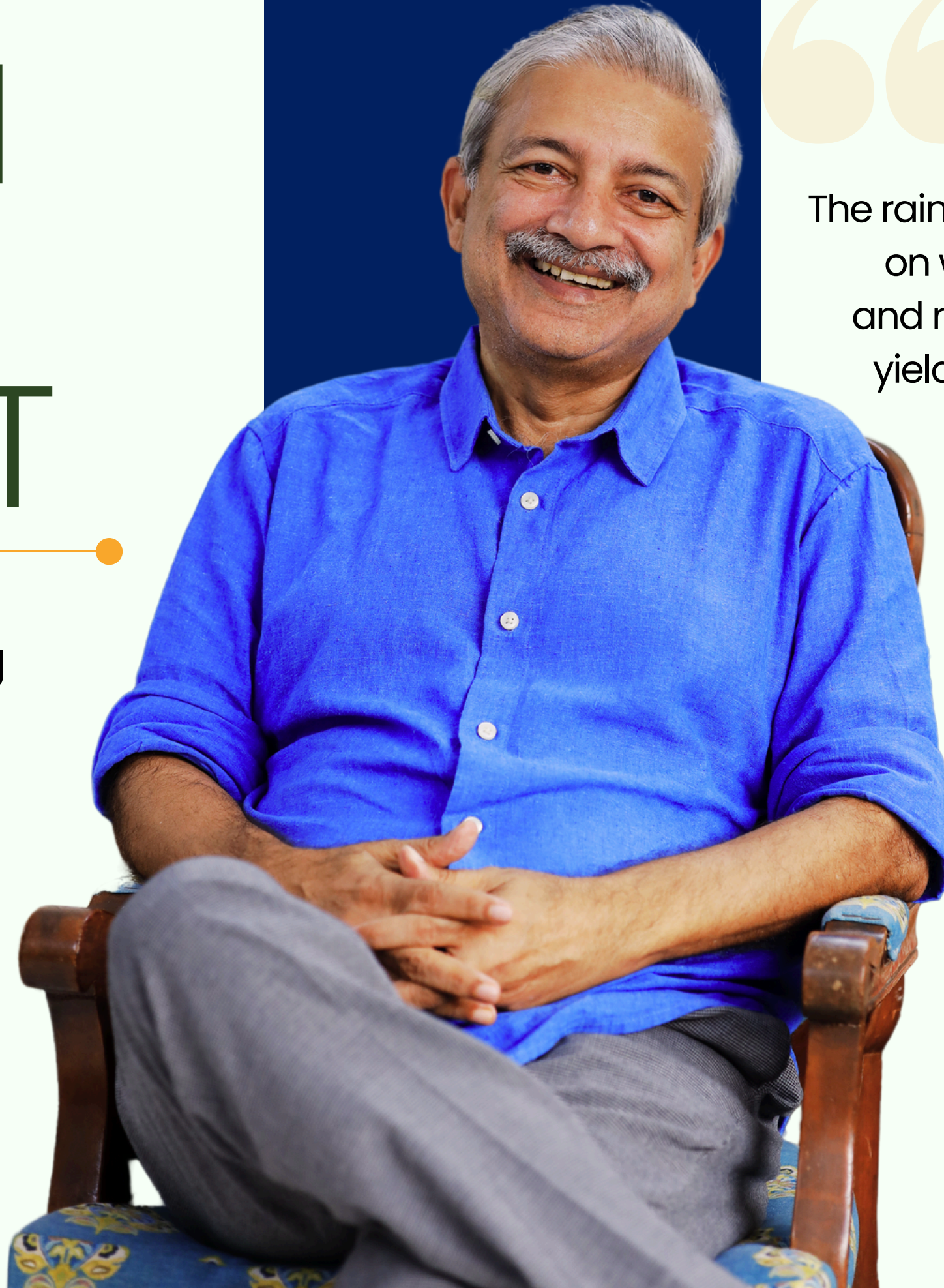

**As part of GVT's ongoing monthly farmer engagement initiative, interactive sessions were held both offline and online this month as well.**



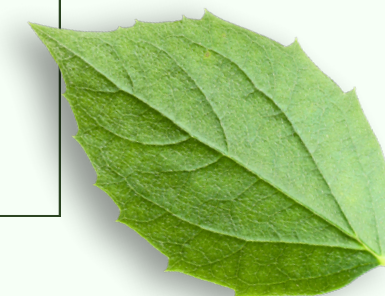
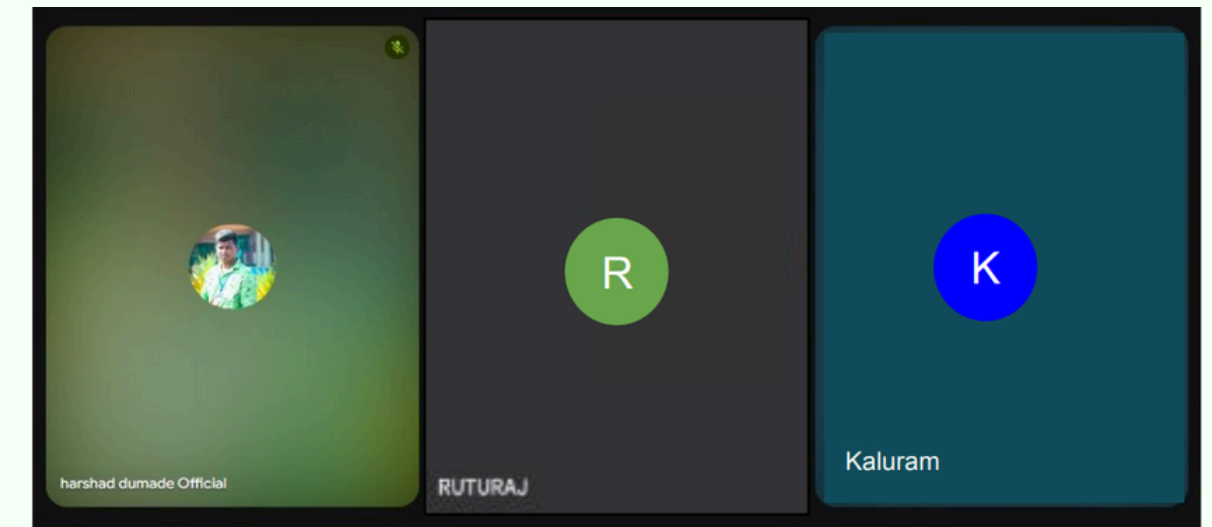
## Offline Meeting – 20 August:

The farmers were also introduced to GVT's new drone-based spraying initiative, which they received with great enthusiasm, reflecting their interest in adopting innovative agricultural practices

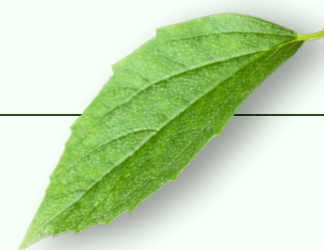

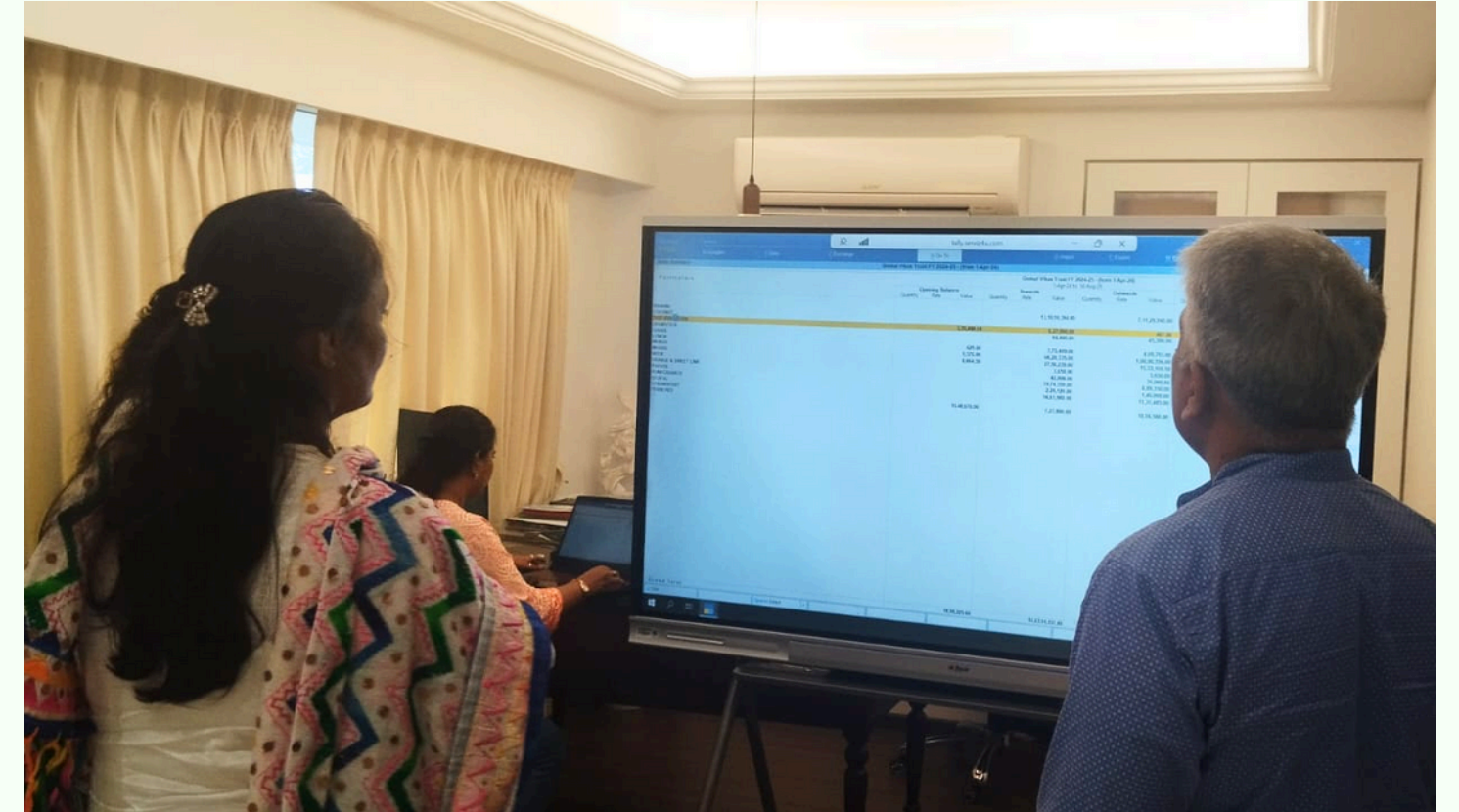
# HDFC BANK CSR REPRESENTATIVE VISIT TO GVT MUMBAI OFFICE
