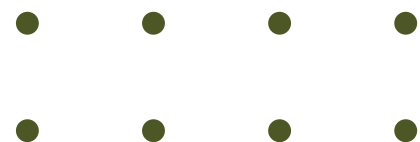
Welcoming a New Season with Our Farmers

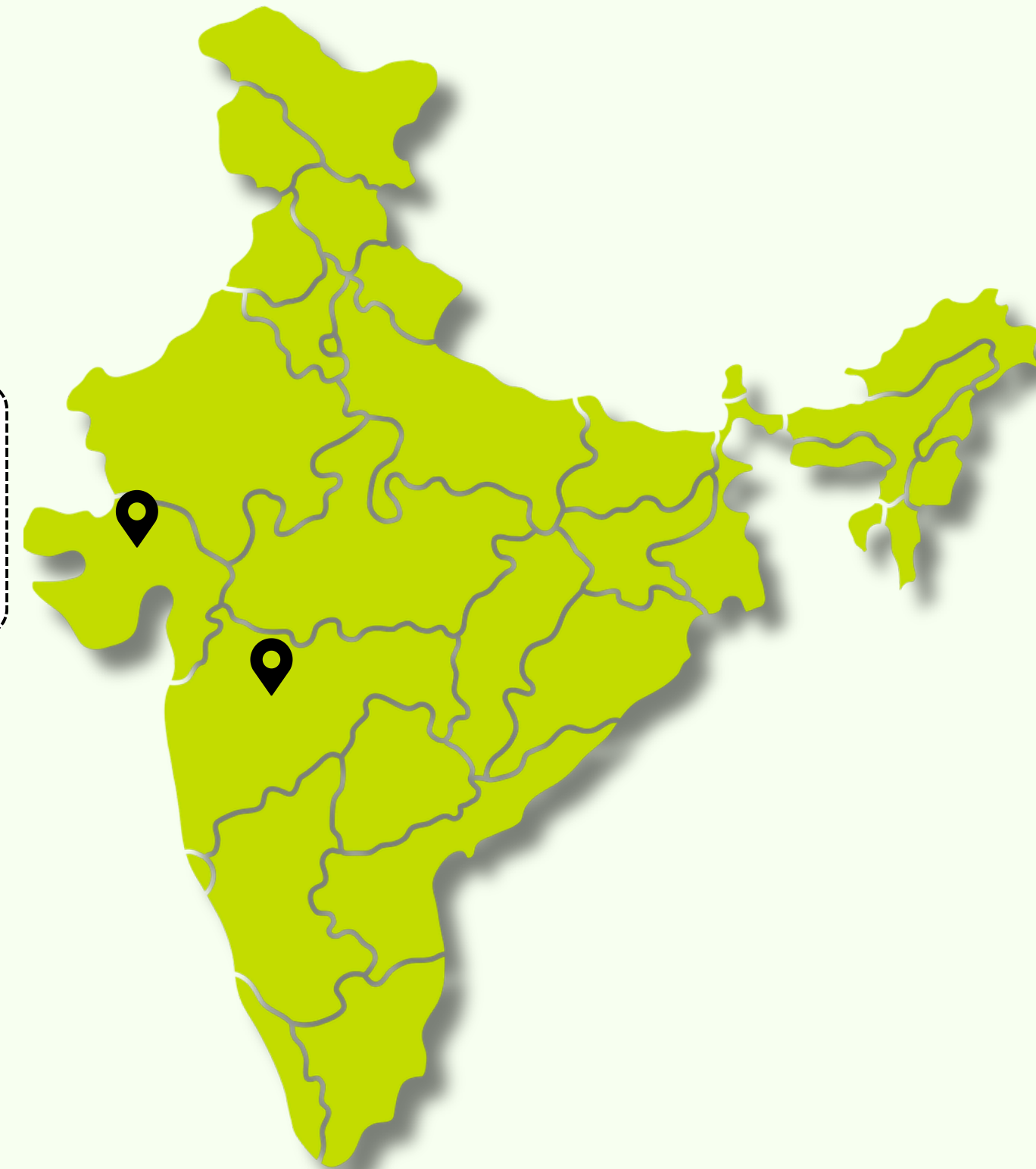
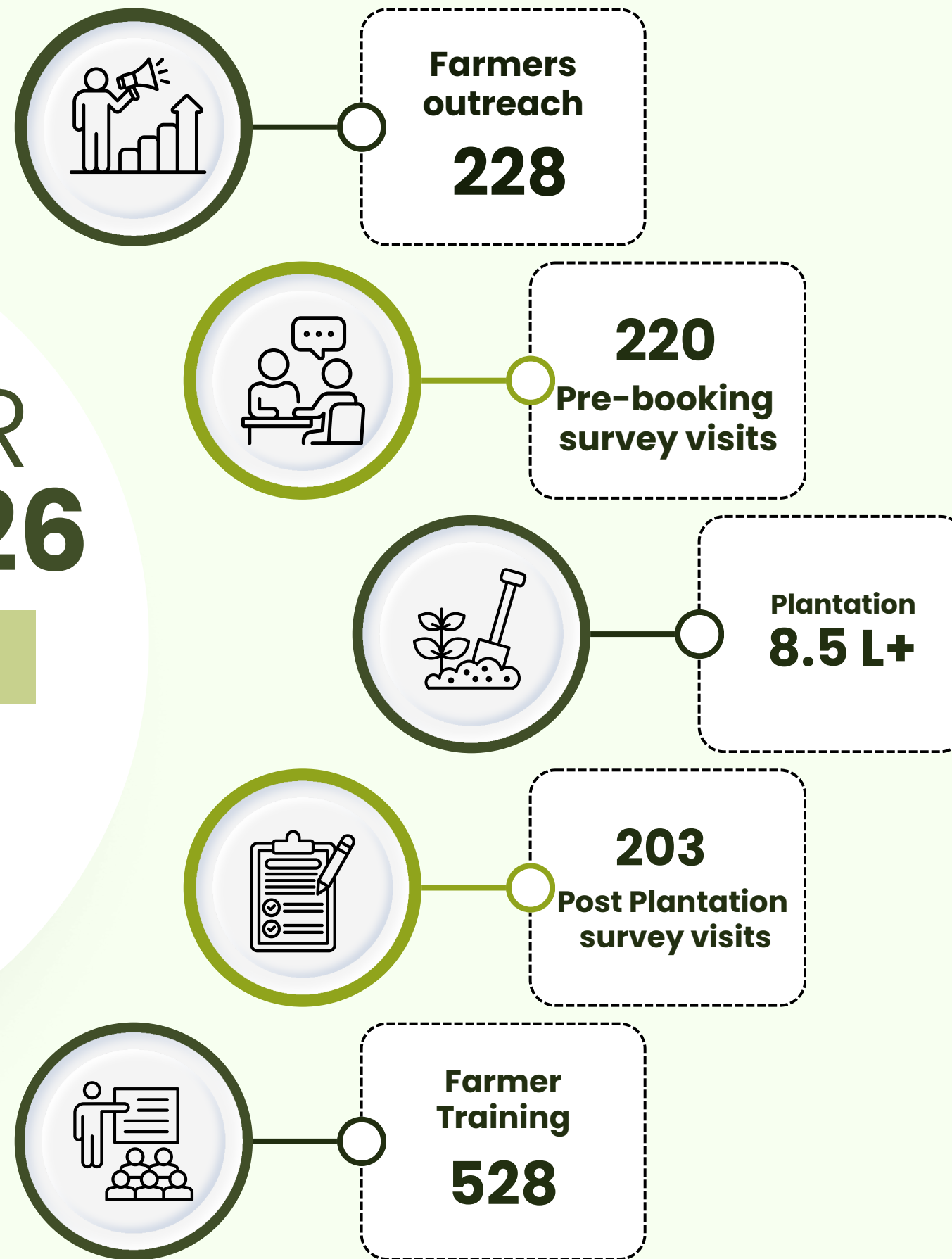

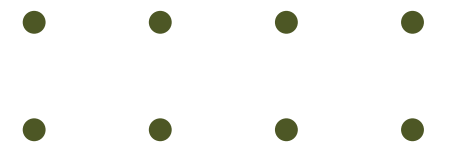
Water Conservation Project Inauguration



To strengthen long-term water security and enhance agricultural resilience, Global Vikas Trust (GVT), with the generous support from Lions Club of Shivaji Park, inaugurated key water conservation initiative in Revli village Beed District

The project includes the installation of 10 GRA efforts to improve rainwater retention and groundwater recharge.

These interventions are expected to significantly boost water availability, laying a strong foundation for sustainable farming and improved livelihoods for the farmers and residents of Revli.

EXPOSURE VISIT:

CadAgro & Bansi Gir Gaushala



As part of the exposure visit, GVT staff visited a Gir Gaushala and Cadila Biotech to gain insights into sustainable agricultural practices and the use of quality inputs. The learnings on soil health, cattle-based inputs, and quality planting material will be further transferred to farmers to improve crop survival, productivity, and overall impact.

FROM CLASSROOM TO FIELD:

Inspiring Future Farmers with Innovation



To inspire the next generation of agricultural leaders and bridge the gap between theory and practice, GVT visited the Agricultural Institute, Kosbad, Dahanu, engaging B.Sc. students with hands-on insights into modern farming. Good personalities shared their journeys with GVT, while one of our team member from Palghar showcased drone technology for precision agriculture. Through this interaction, students gained practical knowledge, explored sustainable farming techniques, and were motivated to innovate, creating a strong foundation for the future of agriculture.

WATER TRANSFORMATION INITIATIVE:

Enabling irrigation and reducing migration

To overcome severe water scarcity and reduce migration, GVT initiated a focused intervention in a drought-affected region. Field assessments identified lack of irrigation as the key constraint, and a nearby water source was selected for a solar-powered water lifting system to ensure reliable access. With farmers ready to adopt year-round cultivation, the initiative is expected to improve water availability, increase cropping intensity, and enhance farmer incomes, creating a sustainable and water-secure model for rural development.

Mulberry training

To address water scarcity, low agricultural productivity, and income instability, GVT conducted targeted capacity-building sessions across Parbhani and Beed districts. Farmers were introduced to scientific practices such as mulberry cultivation and sericulture under initiatives like Maha Reshim Abhiyan 2026 and the POCRA scheme, along with interventions in water conservation and fruit orchard development under the “Samruddha Gaav, Saksham Shetkari” program.

These efforts focused on promoting efficient water use, improving crop performance, and diversifying income sources. Farmers were also guided on government support schemes and future opportunities in sericulture. Collectively, these interventions are contributing to higher productivity, increased incomes, and more resilient rural livelihoods.

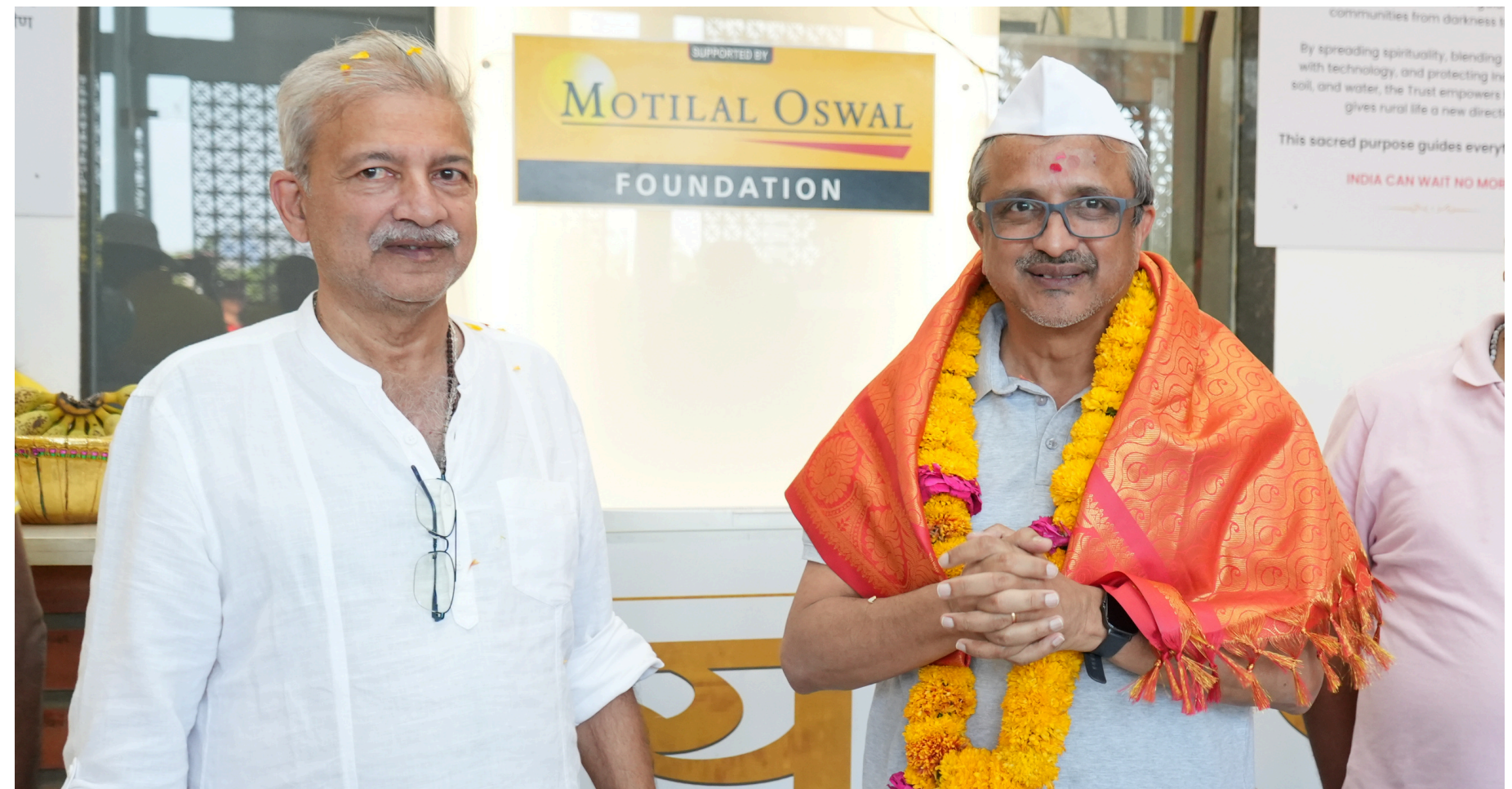


GUEST VISIT:

Assessing progress and strengthening implementation



Mr. Satyajit Bhatkal from Paani Foundation visited GVT Krishikul to gain an in-depth understanding of GVT's implementation approach and field-level impact. During his visit, he interacted with the GVT team to understand the program framework and subsequently visited project sites, where he engaged with farmers and observed on-ground interventions. The visit provided valuable insights into the effectiveness and impact of GVT's initiatives at the community level.



DRIP IRRIGATION SUPPORT



To support farmers who could not even afford basic irrigation systems and were struggling with severe water scarcity, GVT, with the generous support of its donor partner RCDP, implemented a focused intervention across Beed and Dharashiv districts. Drip irrigation systems were provided to small and marginal farmers at a time when crops were failing and uncertainty was high. Today, these systems are helping farmers use every drop efficiently, revive their fields, and move towards better yields and more stable incomes, bringing back hope and confidence in farming



DONOR'S FIELD VISIT FOR MONITORING AND ASSESSMENT OF THE PROJECT



As part of on-ground monitoring and assessment, Mr. Swayang Bikash Jena from the RCDP team visited 14 beneficiaries of GVT's fruit plantation program who had received drip irrigation systems. He interacted with farmers to understand field-level challenges, particularly those arising from heavy rainfall and waterlogging. The visit offered firsthand insights into the effectiveness of the interventions and will help in strengthening program implementation and farmer support.

WATER CONSERVATION WORK

Deepening and widening of 39.76 km of rivers and tributaries in Beed district, Marathwada, has been completed, and similar work is currently in progress in other rivers across the region.
