Necessity is the mother of invention



Here's an interesting story of our farmer from Dolhari, Thakur pada in Vikramgarh, Palghar. Farmer Ravindra Vajya Thakare has been practising a frugal yet innovative way of watering his plants. A few months back, some of his Mogra plants died due to lack of water. So to save the rest of the saplings, the farmer Ravindra, planned to irrigate each sapling drop by drop with the help of waste saline bottles since he was not able to afford a proper drip irrigation system. It is observed that if there is any idea regarding water, the farmer is willing to execute it. Despite the water scarcity and other challenges, our farmer is practising farming using waste bottles & medical saline bottles after sanitizing them carefully. Such farmers are an inspiration for others who wish to thrive in their plantation journey as a farmer.



First distribution in Jalgaon





In our plan of expansion, in this season we started with Jalgaon district which is located in the north-west region of the state of Maharashtra. Our primary focus is on developing existing banana clusters and also cater to farmers interested in other fruits. We wish to magnify this region as an ideal base for banana plantation. Our team has been mobilizing for small scale farmers especially the ones who are new to fruit plantation. Predominantly, farmers have been practicing Cotton, Sorghum, Maize, Wheat and Black grams.

"Shetkari Melawa" in Palghar





The Shetkari fair organized by the Union Minister Kapil Patil Foundation at Shahapur was organized by the Agricultural Produce Market Committee at Shahapur. A stall of Global Vikas Trust was set up at the event. Our team from Palghar encouraged the farmers to participate and learn more about our fruit plantation drive. In this exposure visit we were able to achieve our target of spreading awareness for the farmers towards making sustainable plantation with optimal usage of resources for enriching soil and water resources.

Planning of fertilizer Vs. Organic farming



On a periodic basis we organize a planning meet between our agronomists to create a structure for the information sharing on fertilizer vs. organic farming. This kind of discussions helps us to spread awareness about increasing the fertility, aeration and water holding capacity of the soil. Our team also creates resources for educating our farmers about the right choice of fertilizers in plantation. This is based on the type of soil, availability of water resources and the type of plantation. This helps us make a conscious and calculated decision while also assuring optimum produce for our farmers.

Vermi bed training

Since the inception of our scheme, our ground team across different working regions has been organizing regular training sessions for beneficiary farmers who have expressed interest in vermiculture and have received the needful resources from us which includes vermiculture beds, 3kgs of earthworms, training material etc. for every farmer.

- Impact on soil and crop:
- Improves crop vigour and contributes to a healthy crop
- Imparts disease resistance to crops
- Improves the crops ability to tackle biotic and abiotic stresses
- Crop yield improves with better nutrition availability and resistance from pests and diseases









Custard apple training

Our ground team in Marathwada, organized a series of training sessions, under the guidance of farmer Swapnatai Magar (Progressive Women Farmer for Sitaphal).

The farmers from Nimgaon village in Solapur district expressed a lot of benefit from this. Over 50 farmers were trained in this campaign for custard apple plantation.



"My future has changed forever"

Over a thousand farmers will increase their income 8-10 times

In 2021, for the first time, we planted 53 lakh bananas to increase farmer income across 3,000+ acres in MP and Maha. Was worried if it will work.

We got the best variety of tissue culture banana plants, supplied at subsidized prices and trained the farmers through our experts.

The results have started. One of the first farmers from Burhanpur, M.P., Maheshwar Damu Patil from Khadkod village has just got the first harvest. He had planted 6,000 saplings in his 3.5 acres on 6th June 2021. On 14th April 2022 (10 months), he harvested 11,200 Kgs from around 450 plants @ 25 kg per plant. Right now, he is getting price in local market at Rs. 11 per kg - fetching Rs 1.23 lakhs.





Even if the rate falls to Rs. 8/-, his total plants will fetch him $6000 \times 25 \times 8 =$ Rs. 12.00 lakhs (assuming 2 lakhs of expenses, Rs. 10 lakhs net) for 3.5 acres or Rs 2.85 lakhs per acre. Hope this trend of banana farmers earning over 2.5 lakhs per acre continues. Will keep you posted.

Earlier, they used to grow cotton/rice/soya/lower variety bananas and annually earn around Rs. 10,000-40,000 per acre.

Life transformation in less than a year!

Our model to make India a सोने कि चिड़िया is working with over 15,000 farmers and 1.67 crore fruit trees. Time to scale!
