
Basic Philosophical tenets

1. Water Management

A. Paapnashi River

Work Done -

1. Deepening & widening of Paapnashi River

2017-18 - 10.2 KM 2017-18 - 2.0 KM Total - 12.2 KM

- 2. Recharge Pit on River bank
- 3. 20 borewells have been taken on river bank which will recharge the water.

Future Plan / Work to be completed -

- 1. Repairing work of 5 existing KT dams is in process. Will get completed by end of Sept 18.
- 2. New KT dam to be built in 3 villages.

B. 26 CNB's on tributaries of paapnashi river.

Work Done -

1. 19 CNB work is completed.

Future Plan / Work to be completed

1. 7 CNB's work is in progress.

2) Drip Irrigation

Work Done -

- 1. Farmers sensitization on switching in to drip irrigation is done.
- 2. Total Beneficiary 52

Future Plan / Work to be completed

1. Drip irrigation to be given to 200 farmers by end of Dec,2018.

3) Sericulture

Work Done -

- 1. 110 farmers have done plantation.
- 2. 8 training sessions were conducted with the farmers
- 3. 2 farmers were attended 15 days training in Maysoor out of which one farmer has started chuky center in Rewali Village
- 4. 55 farmers have started taking batches. we have done the survey the example of 5 farmers is given below

- 2. Nadep compost to be built for all the 180 farmers.

4) Tree Plantation

Work Done -

1. Under "Amraiyukt Gaon" we have planted 4000 trees of Kesar mango.

5) Education & Sports.

1. Mr. Santosh Fad running Think sharp foundation and took up our 4 schools for Study Mall in which he will provide E-learning / sports material and library.

6) Smokeless chulhas

Work Done -

1. We have distributed 176 Domestic smokeless chulhaas in 15 villages

Future Plan / Work to be completed

1. Smokeless chulhas to be given to remaining 17 schools.

7) Solar Street Lamp

Work Done -

1. 75 Solar lamps have been installed in all the 15 villages.

8) Mee Sabala

- 1. Our SHG women have put up a stall of cloth bags.
- 2. 2 of our SHG groups have received Rs. 300000/- as an incentive form Govt. to start the goat farm in which GP is motivating them and they have attended 3 rounds of training's. On the occasion Diwali both the groups have purchased 10 female goats (each) and 1 male goat. GP has given 10 goats to each group.
- 3. 3 of our SHG groups have started making various food items and we are promoting them by selling their products. UPL & Borosil are the great supports .



Quarterly report (Mainly Highlights)

3rd December 2018 - Started: step-by-step actions to reach 10 lakh fruit tree plantation.

- 296 Key farmers from the 106 villages of Parli are on the way to reach Jain Hills, Jalgaon in 6 buses for a 3 days field visit and training trip.
- There they will see various different technology of fruit plantation and agronomists and scientists will give them classroom training.
- That will allow them to make informed choice about which fruit plants to grow and why?





5th December 2018 - Global Parli - mission 10 lakh trees

- Day 2 was spent by the 292 farmers travelling from one orchard to another in Jain hills. They saw the technology of drip irrigation, machines, food processing and of course, plantations. They were not remotely aware that farming that they have been doing for centuries has achieved such technology and knowledge. Must have been a shock to them. They are keen to adopt modern agriculture.
- The newly constructed memorial of the visionary founder of Jain Irrigation, Shri Bhawarlal Jain on top of a hill surrounded by orchards, was particularly beautiful.
- Today will be visit to Gandhi Peace Foundation and classroom discussions.
- Life for farmers of Parli is about to take a turn for the better.





6th December 2018 - GLOBAL PARLI - Mission 10 lakh trees

- Jalgaon field visit trip concluded with lectures and presentation by fruit tree agronomists and other dignitaries. Jain irrigation team will guide us on the technical aspects till the mission is achieved.
- For the farmers, lots to think and plan.
- Next level of training and interaction on 18th at Parli.





21st December 2018 - GLOBAL PARLI - 1 million fruit trees

- After conceptualising the plan for growing 1 million fruit trees as a sustainable solution for all the drought-ridden 106 villages of Parli, we have moved a long way ahead.
- After the farmers have been to Jalgaon to see the fields and hear the technical and commercial advantages of growing fruit tree, it was time for the next big public meeting.
- On 18th Dec, hundreds of farmers attended the meeting in which scientists and agronomists explained salient points of each fruit tree and the commercial aspects.
- There was excitement in the air.
- Lives and destiny could be changing.
- We thank Tanya Mistry, Azhaan Merchant and Zarine madam for coming all the way from Mumbai to encourage the villagers. I thank the agronomists who came from Jain irrigation, jalgaon to explain to the farmers and of course, our indefatigable team
