

### PALGHAR NOTEWORTHY EVENT

#### EMPOWERING BANANA FARMERS: TRAINING PROGRAM AT CHALATWAD VILLAGE, PALGHAR



GVT organized a comprehensive training program at Chalatwad village in Jawhar taluka, focusing on banana production under Mahatma Gandhi Rashtriya Gramin Rojgar Hami, Falbag Lagwad Yojana, and the Maharashtra Agriculture Department. The event was attended by 17 banana farmers.

Agriculture Supervisor Mr. Borde and Agriculture Assistant Mr. Patil represented the Taluka Agriculture Department in this informative session.

### PALGHAR NOTEWORTHY EVENT

#### EMPOWERING BANANA FARMERS: TRAINING PROGRAM AT CHALATWAD VILLAGE, PALGHAR

Key topics covered during the training included:

- Fertilizer management during the first, second, third, and fourth months after banana plantation.
- Identification and management of diseases affecting banana crops within the initial two months.
- Effective water management practices.
- Nutrient management strategies.
- Measures to improve soil health and increase organic matter.

The attending farmers and Mr. Borde expressed their appreciation and requested that GVT continue organizing such valuable training programs in the future. Following the training, a meeting was held with the heads of the agriculture departments in Wada, Jawhar, and Vikramgad, where GVT's work was discussed. Information booklets and training reports were distributed to further support the agricultural community.

# MARATHWADA NOTEWORTHY EVENT

#### Collaborative Visit by Krishi Vigyan Kendra (KVK) Ambajogai Scientists to Krishikul



A fruitful visit took place at Krishikul Sirsala, where our Managing Trustees Mayank Gandhi, Sanjay Parmar, and the GVT staff, along with Mr. Deshmukh, Mr. Kardile, and Mr. Sangle from Krishi Vigyan Kendra (KVK) Ambajogai, engaged in discussions about the planted demonstration plots.

- In-depth discussions covered topics such as Krishikul's farmers' training program, training syllabus, soil testing, and information on the Entomology and Pathology laboratory.
- The team conducted a thorough assessment of the current conditions of the cowshed, automation and irrigation unit, biogas unit, and various demo plots featuring crops like Banana, Papaya, Strawberry, Custard Apple, Mango Kesar, and mix Mango.
- Valuable technical insights were shared, contributing to the enhancement of Krishikul's initiatives.
