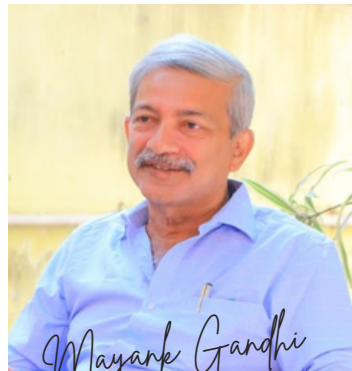
Proper water management not only helps in ensuring that our water resources last longer, but also ensures that the plants only receive the water that they need, which largely prevents the wastage of water.

The first step was to identify the affected part. Later, GVT not only helped farmers identify the pest but also provided pest management training.
