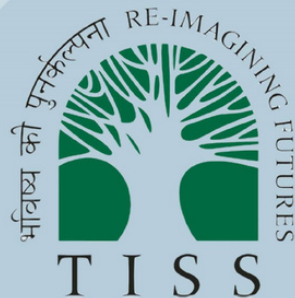

Cow based sanatani agriculture at Krishikul

At Krishikul, our ancient science of cow-based sanatani farming takes center stage, reflecting a commitment to sustainable and eco-friendly agricultural practices. This effective yet simple farming technique was developed by Gopal Sutaria of Bansi Gir Goshala. This system uses a Go-Krupa Amrutam bacterial culture that is derived from completely natural ingredients which include panchgavya (Gomutra, Gomay, milk, curd, and ghee) and Ayurvedic herbs. It has over 70 strains of friendly bacteria that are both aerobic and anaerobic, and which perform useful functions in the soil.

Green manuring fertilizers lay the foundation for robust plant growth, complemented by enriching the soil with compost manures before planting.

As the plants mature, a customized mix of organic fertilizers is applied according to the specific growth needs of each plant. Drip irrigation is employed to administer bacterial fertilizers and additional supplements like Biomix, Gokripa Amratam, Vermiwash, banana suckers, flower extracts, and bael fruit extract contribute to the overall health and vitality of the crops.

Pest and disease control at Krishikul embraces organic solutions, featuring Dasparni Arka, Neem extract, Neem karanj oil, egg disinfectant, Biomix, and Gokripa Amratam applied through careful spraying techniques.

Plus, we use smart ways to keep pests away without using harmful chemicals. Krishikul is like a happy song for plants, where we take care of them naturally and healthily.

Guest Visit: Mr. Vijay Kanade and Mr. Shiv Prasad Kore



The visit by the team from Rashtriya Swayamsevak Sangh (RSS) to Krishikul marked an insightful exploration of agricultural initiatives. Led by Mr. Vijay Kanade (President of Gram Vikas Sangh, Maharashtra and Goa) and Mr. Shiv Prasad Kore (from Shri Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj Goshala, Ranisawargaon), the visit encompassed various facets of farming practices, including fruit crop demonstrations, goshala (cow shelter), and silk cultivation areas. Engaging discussions with farmers like Sugandha Rupnar shed light on plant cultivation, fruit production, and income generation strategies. Additionally, the inspection of Papnashi river projects highlighted efforts towards water management and sustainability. Overall, the visit fostered a valuable exchange of ideas and experiences aimed at enhancing agricultural practices and rural development.

Empowering Farmers: training sessions in villages - Karsud (Vikramgad) and Pinjal (Wada)



Global Vikas Trust organized mogra farming training sessions in village Karsud, Vikramgad Taluka, and village Pinjal, Wada Taluka, attended by 70 enthusiastic farmers. Led by GVT agronomist Ashish Bujad and Prof. Uttam Sahane from KVK Kosbad, the sessions provided invaluable on-field guidance. Farmers delved into various aspects of mogra farming, covering crucial topics such as pest and disease management, protection from fungus, effective spraying methods, fertilizer selection, the benefits of biological pesticides, and mogra pruning techniques. It was an interactive and informative session aimed at empowering farmers with practical knowledge for successful mogra cultivation.

PALGHAR NOTEWORTHY EVENT

Exploring collaborative pathways: GVT and agriculture department in Vikramgad



Following successful mogra training sessions, Mr. Chandrakant Patil, an officer of the agriculture department in Vikramgad, took the initiative to discuss collaboration opportunities. Ashish, representing Global Vikas Trust (GVT), met with him to explore areas of mutual interest.

They exchanged insights into GVT's agricultural initiatives in the Palghar region, including mogra, G9-banana, Velchi banana, and mango plantations, along with sustainable practices like vermicomposting and G-Krupa Amrutam. Discussions also revolved around government schemes and subsidies available for farmers, particularly for mogra and banana cultivation. Both parties agreed to organize further meetings focused on mogra farming in Vikramgad village next month, fostering stronger collaboration for agricultural development.
