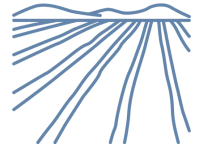

Marathwada Noteworthy Events



In the month of April, Global Vikas Trust successfully encouraged farmers to cultivate sericulture with the aim of increasing their economic level through income generation. To aid in this effort, the organization provided financial assistance to those farmers who were unable to build silk production sheds due to financial difficulties. AU Small Finance Bank provided loans of Rs. 2,20,000 to these farmers at a low interest rate .
