## Visit from the Rotary Club of Kandivali

Members of the **Rotary Club of Kandivali** visited the village of Raikarpada, Shirvanje in Shahapur taluka, under the Integrated Fruit Planting Program. The team surveyed the individual farmers land. In addition to this, they also collected necessary documents and discussed the issue of **water management** with the farmers in that region.



## Mobilization at Baliwali Village





The "Paddy Crop Farming Session" was organized by Wada Agriculture Department in Baliwali village. Representative of Global Palghar, Manoj Bundhe, was invited by the Agriculture Assistant to provide information about our initiative of increasing farmer income by multiple times by changing cropping patterns. The event was attended by the Department of Agriculture, Jijavu Association, Global Vikas Trust Team, and around 25 to 30 farmers from the village.

The farmers present at the workshop located at Shelavali Group Gram Panchayat Office, were informed about the Global Palghar initiatives and guidance provided on Mogra floriculture, fruit tree plantation, and the process of installation of vermi compost.

## **River Recharge Shaft**

Amar Joshi, a geologist, visited our recharge borewell sites. He ensured that the borewells were drilled correctly, to make sure that a large amount of water percolates into the soil, and joins the aquifers underground.

Till now we have drilled 100+ recharge shafts, which will result in an increase in groundwater level in the region.

## **Mango Cultivation**

A workshop was conducted on Mango cultivation and marketing of its production in **Vanevadi**, a village from **Osmanabad Taluka**.

The chief lecturers are as follows: **Dr. Bhagwan Kapse** (The chief lecturers, mango expert, Aurangabad), **Tirthakar** (District Agriculture Officer, Osmanabad), **Mandlik Saheb** (Krishi Vigyan Kendra, Tuljapur), **Dr. Jadhav** (Taluka Agriculture Officer, Kalamb) and **D.P Jadhav** (Taluka Agriculture Officer, Osmanabad). A booklet was given to all dignitaries and farmers present, and detailed information was shared about Global Parli to them.





Sunil Patil, an experimental farmer from Baliwali village in Wada taluka, has planted Mogra in his field for the last 4 years, and Sonchafa for the last year.

The staff of Global Palghar, along with the Wada Agriculture Department, visited his farm where he has constructed a pond to increase water availability by covering the pond with plastic cover at his own cost.

Farmers in the village have also shown interest in purchasing Vermicompost beds from the Global Vikas Trust.
