
From my heart

डजार किसान परिवारों की किस्मत बदल दी हैं। इन्होंने 2022-23 में संस्वा ग्लोबल विकास रुपर के सहवोग से केले के करीब 43 लाख पेप लागा और पर्ने बेककर इसरी फर्मा के सकाबने करीब 16 जन प्रवाद कमाई की।






