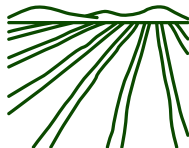

## TISS ASSESSMENT AND POSITIVE FEEDBACK



During the planned survey period from November 2nd to November 8th, 2023, the TISS team, in collaboration with GVT staff, successfully surveyed a total of 250 farmers. A focus group discussion (FGD) led by Mr. Atman Padale engaged 10 farmers who responded positively, expressing their appreciation for GVT's support. Additionally, Mr. Atman Padale visited the Horticulture department in Barwani, receiving commendable feedback from the Horticulture director. Also, Mr. Gandharv visited one Papaya and three Banana fields, encountering positive responses from the farmers.

# BURHANPUR NOTEWORTHY EVENT

## GVT'S WORK: IMPACT ASSESSMENT BY TISS



TISS conducted a comprehensive impact assessment during their visit to Burhanpur, evaluating GVT's transformative impact on farmers' practices and the agricultural landscape. The team surveyed 145 GVT farmers, engaged in a productive FGD with 10 participants in Nimbola village, and explored collaborations with KVK, Horticulture Department, and private agri input shops. The assessment aimed to gauge how GVT is driving positive change in farmers' practices and contributing to overall agricultural betterment.
