





1st Advisory committee meeting

The first success of the prototype in Parli Taluka, consisting of 106 villages, in 2020 has made us take up an ambitious plan to replicate and scale-up the project in other parts of the country.

This will re-emphasize the learnings from Parli as well as help fine tune and enhance a strategy for multiplying farmer incomes in varied circumstances, geographies and governance environments.

Next steps for 2021 2022:

*Facilitate the setting of replicable models across India (We have initiated dialogues for planting fruit trees in Palghar and Ratnagiri (Maharashtra), Rae Bareli (UP), Ariyalur (TN), Bhavnagar (Gujarat) and few other places across India. These would be over-and-above the above 3 million plantations.


* Creating different models to cover all bases for going National – Bottoms-up model, Top-down model, Hybrid model, Franchise model, Clubs and other NGOs-partnered, Industry-partnered, government-partnered models etc.

On Ground Training Sessions

On field Training sessions were organised in Bareilly and Vidisha. Nitin Kopre, Parli Farmer along with agronomist Satish Borange gave training on papaya plantation. They explained about the type of soil required for papaya plantation, distance between the crops, how the saplings are planted, size of the pit, what is the right amount of water it needs, which intercrop to be planted at what distances, drip irrigation etc. More than 100 farmers attended these training sessions.

Global Parli ensures proper planting of trees so that our farmers follow the right procedures to ensure proper output which will benefit them by increasing their incomes.




