Three goat formula: merging economic growth with social reform

In a village named Rui, nestled in Maharashtra's Marathwada region, GVT's meaningful journey took root. It began with a plea for water harvesting back in November 2022, eventually into an ambitious initiative growing involving river development, check dams, and recharge shafts. But this tale isn't just about water; it's about transforming lives. It's about a heartfelt request I made to the community. I appealed to them to stop selling illicit liquor to shield the youth of the village and foster a better future. What followed was a remarkable change - a unanimous decision taken by the community to ban the sale of 'daaru'. To support this transition, on October 13, 2023, GVT provided three pregnant goats to each shopkeeper, enabling them to sustain their livelihoods through goat-rearing. This story is a testament that mere economic growth isn't enough if the social fabric is frayed.

Increasing incomes without social reforms is like a bucket with a hole.

Dashparni Training: Organic solutions for Mogra pest control



An insightful event took place in Dahanu taluka, focusing on on-field farmer training. The session emphasized the application of organic fertilizers like Dashparni to manage pest and disease attacks on Mogra plantations. The GVT team prepared the Dashparni solution for practical result testing, providing a liter of the solution to each attending farmer. Detailed information was provided, encompassing solution preparation, its advantages, targeted insects, and more. The knowledgeable staff further offered guidance on fertilizer and spray management, Mogra pruning techniques, and the utilization of vermicompost in the field.
