#### Shaping the Future of Agriculture: GVT Krishikul Inauguration






#### **OVERALL MONTH WISE** PLANTATION





The inauguration ceremony of GVT Krishikul - Farmer Training Centre took place on October 12, 2024, marking a significant milestone in GVT's mission to empower farmers with knowledge and skills. Supported by the Motilal Oswal Foundation, the event saw the presence of Motilal Oswal and Raamdeo Agrawal. The response was overwhelmingly positive, with farmers, traders, and government officials from various sectors attending to witness the beginning of a transformative era in sustainable and innovative farming.







On October 25, 2024, Vasantrao Naik Marathwada Krishi Vidyapeeth (VNMKV), Parbhani, and Global Vikas Trust (GVT) convened a significant meeting to discuss future collaboration aimed at benefiting farmers. The meeting was attended by our respected trustees Mr Mayank Gandhi and Mr Sanjay Parmar, GVT staff, and VNMKV Vice Chancellor Dr Indramani, along with other university staff. The discussion focused on joint initiatives and strategies to support and uplift the farming community in the coming years.

With GVT Krishikul—the farmer training centre—having taken its final shape and inaugurated on October 12th, farmers and students from nearby districts have started visiting. Krishikul had **38 visitors** in September and **478 visitors** in October.

## **FARMER GROUP TRAINING** Location: Sheel, Vikramgad

On October 5th, GVT conducted an impactful Farmer Group Training session in Sheel village, Vikramgad Taluka, attended by 25 farmers, including women. The session, led by GVT representatives Harshad, Kiran, Pralhad, Kalpesh, and Manoj, focused on Mogra cultivation.

Key topics covered included identifying pests and diseases in Mogra crops, biological and chemical pest control methods, fertilizer management, vermicomposting techniques, and the use of organic treatments such as Go-krupa Amrutam and Dashparni Ark. The session concluded with hands-on guidance for practical implementation.

Participants expressed their gratitude for the valuable and informative session.














Key topics discussed included pest and disease identification in Mogra crops, fertilizer management, chemical pest control, vermicomposting, and the preparation and application of organic treatments such as Go-krupa Amrutam and Dashparni Ark. The training concluded with practical guidance that was highly appreciated by the farmers for its clarity and relevance to their farming practices.

## FARMER GROUP TRAINING Location : Kurnze, Vikramgad

On October 23rd, GVT conducted a Mogra cultivation training session in Kurnze village, Vikramgad Taluka, with 17 farmers in attendance. The session was led by GVT team members Harshad, Bharat, Kalpesh, Pralhad, and Kiran, who provided valuable insights into essential aspects of Mogra cultivation.



#### Nakshatra Garden

The Nakshatra Garden at Krishikul embodies the profound blend of astrology, Ayurveda, botany, and traditional landscaping rooted in Indian mythology. The term "Nakshatra" in Sanskrit means "that which does not decay," symbolizing timelessness and eternal nature. This garden features 27 symbolic trees or plants, each representing one of the 27 Nakshatras distributed over 12 months. Each plant nurtures its own unique microbiodiversity, fostering a deep connection with the natural world. The presence of these astral trees is believed to create a positive atmosphere, providing spiritual solace, rejuvenation, mental peace, and relaxation, making it a space of holistic well-being.

A farmer from Palghar has transformed his life by **Mogra-Banglori** cultivation. This has led to a profit of ₹15,100 in 1 year from 0.09 acre. If calculated on a pro-rata basis the profit could be 1.67 lakh per acre per annum.

Which technique involves plowing along the contours of a slope to reduce water runoff and soil erosion?

#### **Continuous Contour Trenches (CCTs)**

These trenches are dug along contour lines to trap water and silt, preventing soil erosion and increasing water seepage. This significantly raises the water levels in nearby wells, percolation tanks, and lakes. CCTs are typically 30 to 45 cm deep and spaced 3 meters apart in hilly areas where the land slope is between 0% and 33%.


